






<p>Week Beginning: 19th February 2018 Theme: Superheroes</p>  <p>The children will be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Reading a selection of stories including Supertato and Superworm and looking at the features of comic strips. • Designing their own superheroes and thinking about different super powers. • Creating their own comic strips and storyboards using sentences and descriptive words. • Using fabric and other materials to design their own superhero costumes and capes. • Ordering objects by height and length and using non-standard units of measure to make comparisons. • Learning about Chinese New Year. 	<p>Week Beginning: 26th February 2018 Theme: Julia Donaldson</p>  <p>The children will be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Reading a selection of Julia Donaldson stories including The Smartest Giant in Town and A Squash and A Squeeze. • Retelling well-known stories in their own words using sentences and descriptive vocabulary. • Creating their own giant shoes using a variety of materials and techniques including sewing. • Thinking about how they can stay healthy and clean and taking part in a hand-washing workshop. • Ordering objects by height and length and using non-standard units of measure to make comparisons. 	<p>Week Beginning: 5th March 2018 Theme: Eric Carle</p>  <p>The children will be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Reading a selection of Eric Carle stories including The Very Hungry Caterpillar and the Bad Tempered Ladybird. • Designing their own bug homes and making them using a variety of natural materials and tools. • Finding out about the lifecycle of the butterfly and identifying the different stages of its development. • Beginning to identify times on an analogue clock and measuring short periods of time using timers and stopwatches. • Finding out about symmetry and making their own symmetrical pictures and patterns.
