Theme: Superheroes All Around Us

Week Beginning: Monday 8th January 2018 This Week's Theme: My Family and School



We will be:

- Learning about the different jobs our family members do, including jobs that have to be done at home
- Listening to guest speakers and asking questions about the things we see and hear
- Finding about different jobs that have to done in school
- Listening to stories about different families and making connections with our own experiences
- Recognising numbers 1 to 10 and counting objects out from a larger group
- Writing words using our phonic skills and learning the last set of sounds in set one

Week Beginning: Monday 29th January 2018
This Week's Theme: Police



We will be:

- Finding out about the different jobs done by the Police
- Making wanted posters and missing posters and thinking about extending our sentences
- Reading a selection of stories about the police and how they help people
- Finding out about the equipment used by the Police and having a visit from a police dog and handler
- Finishing set one of the phonics sounds and practicing reading and writing using our phonics skills
- Ordering two or more objects by height and length

Week Beginning: Monday 15th January 2018 This Week's Theme: Superheroes In Brentford

We will be:

- Finding out about the different jobs that are done in Brentford everyday including the work done by post people, bus drivers and shop workers
- Visiting different shops and local work places including the train station, canal and Morrisons
- Thinking about what jobs there might be in the future and identifying what jobs they would like to do
- Making maps and broachers about different jobs and work places
- Reading a selection of stories and making lists
- Selecting the correct numeral to match a total and practice number formation

Week Beginning: Monday 5th February 2018 This Week's Theme: Fire Fighters



We will be:

- Finding out about the different equipment and tools used by Fire Fighters and thinking about how they help people
- Making our own fire engines and thinking about how we could improve them
- Having a visit from the fire service and talking to them about their jobs
- Talking about fire safety and how we can stay safe in the event of an emergency
- Ordering objects by weight and capacity and using appropriate language

Week Beginning: Monday 22nd January 2018 This Week's Theme: Nurses and Doctors



We will be:

- Finding out about the work done by Doctors and Nurses and talking about the different work they do
- Reading a selection of stories about going to the doctors including Topsy and Tim
- Listening to a guest speaker and finding out the equipment they use and the role they have in helping people
- Identifying different tools and equipment used at the doctor's surgery and the hospital and making cards
- Recalling past experiences and making posters and labels
- Counting groups of objects to 10 and beyond
