



St Paul's CE Primary School Academic Results 2016-17

Early Years – End of Reception Class

73% of pupils achieved the *Good Level of Development* in 2016-17. The national average was 69% in (2015/16.)

Year 1 – Phonics Screening Check

88% of pupils achieved the phonics screening check standard in 2016-17. The national average was 81%.

End of Key Stage 1 – Phonics Screening Check

89% of pupils leaving year 2 in 2016-17 achieved the phonics screening check standard. The national average was 92%.
