

Statement on Pupil Premium Allocation

2016-17

The amount of Pupil Premium Allocation – 2016-17

In the academic year 2016-17 the school has been allocated:

£102 750 (school funding certificate)

plus carried forward from 15-16 £7593

Total for 2016 -2017 is **£103,503**

Summary of Main Barriers Faced by Pupils:

- often have other needs which impact progress – may have other characteristics – SEN/EAL/Mobility
- not able to frequently read at home - engagement
- face hardship – opportunity to build cultural capital
- Have aspiration, but may be unclear how to secure it

Current 2016-17 cohorts, using end of 2015-16 data

- Y2 – greater percentage than non-pp pupils in well below for reading & especially writing – PP pupils underperformed in Y1 phonics screener
- Y3 - no pp exceeding in reading, writing, maths. Progress lower for PP in reading and maths, but higher in writing
- Y4 – Progress in reading, writing matches. Although attainment in reading, writing, maths has greater proportion of pp pupils at exceeding
- Y5 –progress broadly in line in reading, writing, maths. PP pupils lower proportion in exceeding
- Y6 – progress for PP pupils exceeds non-pp pupils.

Spending of Allocation for 2016-17

- Additional teacher in EY classes in Autumn term 2016 – **to support early acquisition of phonics and early reading**. To support EY team in **achieving GLD for EY PP pupils, in line with Non-PP pupils**, in order to prevent a gap developing in the earliest stage.
- Additional teacher in KS1 classes to **provide support for PP phonics in Year 2 and reading, writing across KS1** – deployed by class teachers
- Provision of additional English and Maths set in Year 5&6 – to secure progress and attainment in
- An additional support teacher **precision teaching year 5/6 pupils** under direction of CT
- Provision of a pupil premium advocate to provide learning enrichment activities, **maximise the take up of pupil premium, identify and work alongside charities** and other organisations to support the pp families.
