

St Paul's CE Primary School Academic Results 2020-21

The Academic years 2019-20 and 2020-21 were both disrupted by the COVID pandemic. This led to school closures and a disruption to teaching and learning across England. As a result, statutory national assessment did not take place in these two years.

The school conducted internal assessments, mirroring the statutory requirements in each of the affected years, in many of the areas. The result from these assessments are recorded below.

2020-21 – INTERNAL DATA

Early Years - End of Reception Class

76% of pupils achieved the *Good Level of Development* in 2020-21. In 2018-19 the national average was 72%.

Year 1 – Phonics Screening Check

This check was completed out of sequence in December 2021 for pupils in Year 2, rather than in the previous June due to school closures. 93% of pupils achieved the phonics screening check standard. The national average in 2018-19 was 82%.

End of Key Stage 1 – Phonics Screening Check

This check was completed in June 2021 for pupils then in Year 2, 96% of pupils leaving year 2 in 2020-21 achieved the phonics screening check standard. The national average in 2018-19 was 91%.

This check was completed out of sequence in December 2020 for pupils then in Year 2, rather than in the previous June due to school closures. 88% of pupils achieved the phonics screening check standard. The national average in 2018-19 was 82%.

73% of pupils achieved the *Good Level of Development* in 2018-19. The national average was 72% (2019)

Year 1 – Phonics Screening Check

89% of pupils achieved the phonics screening check standard in 2018-19. The national average was 82% (2019)

End of Key Stage 1 – Phonics Screening Check

95% of pupils leaving year 2 in 2018-19 achieved the phonics screening check standard. The national average was 91%.(2019). 73%, 8 out of 11 pupils, who hadn't secured the standard in year 1 secured it in year 2.
