<p>Week Beginning: 1st October 2018 Theme: In the Garden</p> <p>The children will be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Learning a selection of rhymes including Incy Wincy Spider and Mary, Mary Quite Contrary. • Creating observational drawings of flowers and natural objects. • Creating spider and flower models using recycled materials. • Visiting the local park and identifying what they see and hear. • Finding out about spiders; where they live and what they look like. 	<p>Week Beginning: 8th October 2018 Theme: Harvest</p> <p>The children will be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Reading the story 'The little red hen' and learning about where bread comes from. • Making our own bread and tasting bread from around the world. • Finding out about how vegetables are grown and planting our own vegetables. • Tasting different vegetables and making vegetable soup. • Taking part in whole school harvest celebrations and visiting the church. • Learning rhymes including Old MacDonald and Baa Baa Black Sheep. 	<p>Week Beginning: 15th October 2018 Theme: Fairy Tale Characters</p> <p>The children will be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Learning a selection of rhymes including Humpty Dumpty and the Grand Old Duke of York. • Creating their own version of the Humpty Dumpty character and creating a safe place for him to stay. • Building using a variety of materials including bricks and construction kits. • Looking at different types of transport and talking about their own experiences. • Making their own puppets and using them to create stories and retell rhymes.
