Welcome to our round up of news and information for the week.

Mobile Phones

Over the last few years, we have seen increasing problems with the use of social media and mobile phones, which spill over into school, impacting friendships and learning. No primary aged pupil should have a social media account as these apps are not designed for children and present real safeguarding risks, including cyberbullying. We have experienced very worrying risks and behaviours where children have been able to use these tools inappropriately. We have therefore decided to revise our approach towards mobile phones.

From the start of the Spring term 2024, we will not allow pupils to bring mobile phones and smart devices onto the school premises – even if turned off. There is no place in school for such devices.
