Saturday 8th June 2024

Join us for a daytrip to Worthing, a traditional seaside resort on the south coast. Once the coach arrives in Worthing the day is yours to:

- paddle
- swim
- sunbathe (or cover from the wind and rain!!)
- build sandcastles
- picnic
- have fish 'n' chips
- visit the boating lake
- catch crabs from the quay
- visit the shops and much more besides.

This is a trip for families and friends of the school. All children must be accompanied and supervision is the responsibility of the family.

Tickets: £18 per passenger. For Pupil Premium* eligible pupils the price is reduced to £10.80. (THIS IS THE SAME PRICE AS LAST YEAR!). Coach leaves St Paul's School at 9am (sharp) and leaves Worthing at 5pm (sharp).

Bookings should be made on *ParentPay*. Places for the trip are limited. Bookings close on **Friday 10th May 2024**. Tickets will be issued shortly afterwards.

Terms and Conditions:

- All payments are non-refundable.
- The school will use a reputable coach company and take all reasonable steps to ensure the trip is safe, however accepts no responsibility for the safety or supervision of attendees.
- All children must be accompanied and supervised by a responsible adult, over the age of 18.
- Participants on the trip must not drink to excess. (Sorry, I just need to make this clear)
- Each passenger, regardless of age, must buy a ticket – the coach company will not allow babies and young children to travel in the same seat as an adult.
- The coach will leave promptly – latecomers may miss the coach.
- We reserve the right to cancel and refund tickets where there is insufficient take up.
