#### 150th Anniversary of St Paul's School



2023 marks the 150<sup>th</sup> anniversary of our school. The school first opened its doors to pupils in 1873. Throughout this academic year, we will be holding a series of events to mark and celebrate our 150<sup>th</sup> Year. The first of these events takes place next Thursday, 28<sup>th</sup> September. We shall have a service of thanksgiving and celebration at 11am as St Paul's church. This service is for pupils (Y1-6), staff, community guests and parents. As we have a fixed capacity, we shall have to limit the number of participants. **This will be a ticketed event**. We are offering tickets (allowing admission for a maximum of 2 people). The tickets to

attend are free and will be distributed on a first come, first serve basis.

We shall send home a ticket with your child at the end of the school day next week. **Please bring your ticket with you on the day and arrive to be seated by 10:50 am.** 

Later on the same day, we shall be burying a time capsule in the school playground. As we have more space, this event is open for all parents to attend. We shall hold this event in the SPS school playground at 1:30pm. Entry for parents will be via the large black vehicle gate opposite the church nursery entrance.

# Reception – Year 6 Flu Vaccination – Friday 3rd November 2023

The annual Flu vaccination (administered by nasal spray) for pupils in Reception to Year 6 will be taking place on Friday 3rd November 2023.

**Flu vaccinations will only be given with parental consent**. The vaccination is free of charge. The consent process is electronic. If parents would like their children to have the Flu Spray they need to give consent online. **Children for whom consent has not been given online will not receive the Flu Spray.** The deadline date is midday on Thursday 2nd November.


