Friday 20th October – INSET DAY



A Message from the Children's Commissioner – The Big Ambition Survey

Over the next few months, my team and I will be visiting schools, colleges, children's homes, secure children's homes, residential special schools, hospitals, young offender institutes, youth clubs and many other locations across England to get children and young people involved, so they can have their say.
