PTA Quiz Night – Thursday 23rd November 2023 - 7pm

For our youngest pupils, they are reflective poppies to attach to bags etc. For older pupils they are the more traditional poppy with a pin to fasten to clothing.

The pupils in Year 5/6 classes will be leading our Remembrance service in church on 9th November. This will be a service of remembrance, rather than a production on a Christian theme. After the service, we shall walk to the Brentford War Memorial at the library to lay a wreath and pray. Parents are welcome to join the service on 09/11.

Dear Katie,

I'm writing on behalf of the volunteers and trustees to thank you, all the students, their families, and the teachers at St Paul's Primary School for your generous Harvest Festival donations to Hounslow Community FoodBox. Your kindness is a shining example of the community spirit that makes Hounslow special.

We all want to see a thriving community, however events over the past few years have impacted on some people's lives more than others as the following statistics bear testimony to – FoodBox volunteers have provided 7-day food parcels right across the London Borough of Hounslow 5 days a week to support 9,300 adults and children in 2022, delivering around 75% of the food parcels to people's homes. 2023 is set to be on par with volumes of that last year. Your support is greatly appreciated in helping us to provide this vital service and your contributions will make a real difference in supporting those in need within our community.

We are constantly needing to re-stock our shelves with the core items that go into food parcels including milk, tinned meat, fish and vegetables and that's why your continuing support, and that of like-minded members of our community, is needed more than ever. Without it we would not be able to offer support to so many who through an unfortunate set of circumstances find it impossible to provide for themselves and their close family.
