<p><b>The RE curriculum in Nursery will be centred around the children’s home experiences in accordance with the Development Matters Document.</b></p> <p>The children will have an opportunity to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Find out what it means to come together to celebrate God at St Paul’s</li> <li>• Begin to learn a selection of songs, stories and prayers (on going)</li> <li>• Take part in Harvest celebrations – Saying thank you for our food</li> <li>• Learn about the stories Jesus told including:               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- The Lost Sheep</li> <li>- The House on the rocks</li> <li>- The Good Stranger</li> <li>- The Precious Pearl</li> </ul>               (Stories Jesus Told by Mick Inkpen)             </li> <li>• Celebrate other religious festivals including Diwali and Eid – making connections with their home experiences</li> <li>• Talk about their preparations for Christmas and their family traditions</li> <li>• Listen to the Christmas story and talk about its significance for Christians</li> </ul>	<p><b>The Feast of St Paul’s occurs on 25<sup>th</sup> January. During this week we celebrate the life of St Paul and his impact on the Christian faith.</b></p> <p>The children will have an opportunity to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Find out about Epiphany and the gifts the three kings gave to Jesus</li> <li>• Talk about gifts they received and their own family traditions</li> <li>• Visit the Church and find out about the offerings</li> <li>• Learn about the work of charities who care for others and share God’s work</li> <li>• Thinking about what it means to give something up</li> <li>• Find out why Christians take part in Lent</li> <li>• Learn about how music is used in churches around the world</li> <li>• Explore what songs mean to ourselves and others</li> <li>• Give thanks to God through song</li> <li>• Think about the place of songs in other religions</li> <li>• Find out about Easter and its importance for Christians</li> </ul>	<p>The children will have an opportunity to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Think about prayer and when we hear prayers</li> <li>• Look at the school prayer and think about what it means</li> <li>• Create their own prayers focusing on their family and things which are important to them</li> <li>• Find out about the Lord’s Prayer and begin to learn it</li> <li>• Look at different versions of the Lord’s Prayer</li> <li>• <b>Old Testament Heroes:</b> Exploring the stories of David, Samuel, Noah, Ruth and others.</li> <li>• Thinking about what we can learn from them.</li> <li>• <b>Who cares for this special world and why?</b></li> <li>• Exploring Creation and how to look after the world around us.</li> </ul>
