

<p>Week beginning: 19<sup>th</sup> April Theme: Dinosaurs</p> <p>The children will be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Reading a selection of stories about dinosaurs including Dinosaur Roar.</li> <li>• Creating masks, puppets and pictures of different dinosaurs.</li> <li>• Finding out about different types of dinosaurs and learning their names.</li> <li>• Identifying and saying numbers to 5 and beyond; identifying one more and one less.</li> <li>• Identifying different vocal sounds and using their own voices to make sounds.</li> </ul>	<p>Week beginning: 25<sup>th</sup> April Theme: Monsters</p> <p>The children will be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Reading a selection of stories including The Ravenous Beast and The Gruffalo.</li> <li>• Retelling well known stories using puppets and masks.</li> <li>• Creating their own menus and making Gruffalo Pie.</li> <li>• Identifying and saying numbers to 5 and beyond; how many are in a group and how many altogether?</li> <li>• Identifying different vocal sounds and identifying how sounds can be changed.</li> </ul>	<p>Week beginning: 2<sup>nd</sup> May Theme: Mermaids and Pirates</p> <p>The children will be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Learning about Eid and finding out how Muslims celebrate around the world.</li> <li>• Reading a selection of stories including The Singing Mermaid and Pirates love underpants.</li> <li>• Creating their own pirate flags and finding out about famous pirate ships.</li> <li>• 2d shapes; selecting and naming a selection of 2d shapes and sorting shapes.</li> <li>• Oral blending and segmenting games.</li> </ul>
<p>Week beginning: 9<sup>th</sup> May Theme: Superheroes</p> <p>The children will be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Reading a selection of stories including Supertato.</li> <li>• Creating their own superhero costumes and masks and models of their secret hideout.</li> <li>• Talking about super powers and identifying what they would like to do and why.</li> <li>• Identifying longer and shorter and sorting objects according to their size.</li> <li>• Oral blending and segmenting games including I spy.</li> </ul>	<p>Week beginning: 16<sup>th</sup> May Theme: Knights, Dragons and Castles</p> <p>The children will be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Reading a selection of stories including Zog.</li> <li>• Creating their own shields and props for retelling stories.</li> <li>• Finding out about dragons and unicorns and creating their own versions using art materials.</li> <li>• Using positional language to describe where an object is placed e.g. in front.</li> <li>• Oral blending and segmenting games and an introduction to the Read Write Inc phonics programme.</li> </ul>	<p>Week beginning: 23<sup>rd</sup> May Theme: Kings and Queens</p> <p>The children will be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Reading a selection of stories including The Queen's Knickers.</li> <li>• Creating pictures and portraits of the Queen and members of the Royal Family.</li> <li>• Taking part in the School's Jubilee Celebrations.</li> <li>• Using words associated with the passage of time e.g. first, before.</li> <li>• Oral blending and segmenting games and an introduction to the Read Write Inc phonics programme.</li> </ul>
