<p>Week Beginning: <b>19<sup>th</sup> February</b>                  Theme: <b>Let's Go For a Walk</b>                   The children will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Learn about the area directly around the school, discussing natural and manmade features.</li> <li>- Locate the school on a simple map.</li> <li>- Start to learn right and left and try to give simple directions.</li> <li>- RE: to understand what it means to give something up (such as for Lent)</li> </ul> <p><i>Key Vocabulary: road, park, Brentford, walk, map</i></p>	<p>Week Beginning: <b>26<sup>th</sup> February</b>                  Theme: <b>Let's Go To The Shops</b>                   The children will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Think about the features of Brentford High Street.</li> <li>- Visit the High Street and look at the shop.</li> <li>- Begin to understand the different types of shops we might visit.</li> <li>- Compare our high street to those in different places.</li> <li>- Learn about local buses and where we might travel on them.</li> <li>- RE: Learn how music is used in churches around the world.</li> </ul> <p><i>Key Vocabulary: shop, buy, pay, same, different, bus</i></p>	<p>Week Beginning: <b>4<sup>th</sup> March</b>                  Theme: <b>Let's Go To The Countryside</b>                   The children will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Learn about the difference between the city and the countryside</li> <li>- Think about which kinds of transport we would use to travel to the countryside from Brentford.</li> <li>- Think about how to travel safely in a car</li> <li>- RE: Visit St Paul's Church to learn what a church is and what happens there.</li> </ul> <p><i>Key Vocabulary: hill, city, countryside, train, car</i></p>	<p>Week Beginning: <b>11<sup>th</sup> March</b>                  Theme: <b>Let's Go Over The Water</b>                   The children will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Make junk model boats thinking about which materials will make sure it will float.</li> <li>- Begin to understand that the UK is an island and to leave it we have to cross the sea</li> <li>- Understand the difference between a river and the sea</li> <li>- RE: Think about the place of songs in religion</li> </ul> <p><i>Key Vocabulary: boat, sea, water, ocean, river</i></p>
<p>Week Beginning: <b>18<sup>th</sup> March</b>                  Theme: <b>Let's Go To Another Country</b>                   The children will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Understand why planes are more efficient for long distance travel.</li> <li>- Learn about the different countries we are from and locate them on a map/globe</li> <li>- Talk about other countries we have been to visit.</li> <li>- Watch the planes going into/out of Heathrow airport.</li> <li>- RE: Find out about the Easter Story</li> </ul> <p><i>Key Vocabulary: aeroplane, take off, landing, fly</i></p>	<p>Week Beginning: <b>25<sup>th</sup> March</b>                  Theme: <b>Let's Go Into The Past</b>                   The children will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Begin to understand that all countries and cultures are different</li> <li>- Try some foods from the countries our families are from</li> <li>- Think about how life was different in the past in the UK and elsewhere</li> <li>- RE: understand the significance of Easter for Christians.</li> </ul> <p><i>Key Vocabulary:</i></p>	<p><b>Throughout the Term the children will:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Start to understand the area they live in and how this relates to other places</li> <li>- Learn about the different modes of transport they might use to travel somewhere</li> <li>- Share their own experiences of using the different types of transport.</li> <li>- Start to correctly write some letters from their names</li> <li>- Create art work using a variety of media and materials.</li> <li>- Use their maths skills and knowledge to solve problems.</li> </ul> <p>PE lessons will focus on games.</p>	<p align="center"><b>Dates for your diary:</b></p> <p><u>Monday 26<sup>th</sup> and Tuesday 27<sup>th</sup> February</u> – Parent's Evenings</p> <p><u>Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> March</u> – World Book Day</p> <p><u>29<sup>th</sup> March - 14<sup>th</sup> April</u> – Easter Holidays</p>
