







<p>Week Beginning: 11th September Theme: Old MacDonald had a farm </p> <p>The children will be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Exploring the Reception classroom and garden - Learning the routines and expectations - Making new friends; learning their names and talking about their likes and dislikes - Listening to a selection of stories and talking about what they see and hear - Finding out about different farm animals and creating pictures, puppets and models of different animals 	<p>Week beginning: 18th September Theme: The Three Little Pigs </p> <p>The children will be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Reading different versions of Three Little Pigs - Creating wanted posters for the Big Bad Wolf and describing what he looks like and what he does - Making houses using a variety of materials and testing their durability - Looking at different types of pigs and creating their own posters about them - Recognising 1: the oneness of one, 1p coin and circles 	<p>Week Beginning: 25th September Theme: Little Red Riding Hood </p> <p>The children will be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Listening to different versions of Little Red Riding Hood and talking about the characters and events - Creating their own representations and models of the wolf - Designing a meal for the Big Bad Wolf and talking about their favourite food - Talking about healthy and unhealthy food and ways to look after our teeth - Recognising 2: $1+1=2$, $2-1=1$, 2p coin, 2 step pattern
<p>Week Beginning: 2nd October Theme: The Enormous Turnip </p> <p>The children will be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Finding out about Harvest celebrations around the world - Making vegetable soup and tasting different types of vegetables - Making bread and trying different types of bread - Reading a selection of stories including the Enormous Turnip - Ordering objects by size and shape and making comparisons - Recognising 3: 1 more than 2, $1+2=3$, triangles 	<p>Week Beginning: 9th October Theme: The Elves and The Shoemaker </p> <p>The children will be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Listening to the story of The Elves and The Shoemaker and sequencing the events that occur - Designing their own shoes and investigating different types of shoes - Measuring their feet using non-standard measures - Talking about being helpful and reading stories about how to help people - Recognising 4: adding and subtracting, ordering objects, recognising 4 by sight, knowing 4 sided shapes 	<p>Week Beginning: 16th October Theme: The Magic Porridge Pot </p> <p>The children will be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Reading the story of the Magic Porridge Pot and thinking about how the events might have been changed - Making and trying porridge and talking about their favourite types of breakfast - Writing their own recipes for a magical breakfast - Retelling their favourite traditional tales using a variety of resources - Recognising 5: counting out 5, using 5 frames and dice, ordering and writing numbers to 5
<p>Ongoing learning: Children will have a daily phonics session. Initially we shall focus on identify orally segmenting and blending words and the initial sounds in words before starting the Read Write Inc Scheme.</p>
