

<p><b>Week Beginning:</b> 10<sup>th</sup> September 2018 <b>Theme:</b> Stay and Play Sessions</p> <p>The children will be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Meeting and interacting with the adults in the Reception base and becoming familiar with the routines and expectations.</li> <li>• Exploring the learning environment and talking about their likes and interests.</li> <li>• Using a variety of tools including scissors, painting tools and play dough equipment.</li> <li>• Managing their own toileting and selecting food from the snack area.</li> <li>• Talking to children engaged in similar activities and sharing their likes and interests.</li> <li>• Joining in with familiar songs and rhymes and listening to stories.</li> </ul>	<p><b>Week Beginning:</b> 17<sup>th</sup> September 2018 <b>Theme:</b> Settling Into Reception</p> <p>The children will be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Meeting and interacting with the adults in the Reception base and becoming familiar with the routines and expectations.</li> <li>• Exploring the learning environment and talking about their likes and interests.</li> <li>• Using a variety of tools including scissors, painting tools and play dough equipment.</li> <li>• Managing their own toileting and selecting food at lunch and for snack.</li> <li>• Talking to children engaged in similar activities and sharing their likes and interests.</li> <li>• Joining in with familiar songs and rhymes and listening to stories.</li> </ul>	<p><b>Week Beginning:</b> 24<sup>th</sup> September 2018 <b>Theme:</b> The Night Sky</p> <p>The children will be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Learning a selection of rhymes including Twinkle Twinkle Little Star and Hey Diddle Diddle.</li> <li>• Creating their own stars using a selection of craft materials.</li> <li>• Making star biscuits; observing the changes to the ingredients as they cook and talking about their experiences of cooking at home.</li> <li>• Making their own puppets and props and retelling well known rhymes.</li> <li>• Reading a selection of stories about stars and space and creating their own representations.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Week Beginning:</b> 1<sup>st</sup> October 2018 <b>Theme:</b> In the Garden</p> <p>The children will be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Learning a selection of rhymes including Incy Wincy Spider and Mary, Mary Quite Contrary.</li> <li>• Learning various versions of the rhyme and creating their own versions.</li> <li>• Observing spider webs and creating their own representations using a variety of materials.</li> <li>• Creating observational drawings of flowers and natural objects.</li> <li>• Creating models using recycled materials and describing what they have done.</li> </ul>	<p><b>Week Beginning:</b> 8<sup>th</sup> October 2018 <b>Theme:</b> Harvest</p> <p>The children will be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Reading the story 'the little red hen' and learning about where bread comes from.</li> <li>• Making our own bread and tasting bread from around the world.</li> <li>• Finding out about how vegetables are grown and planting our own vegetables.</li> <li>• Tasting different vegetables and making vegetable soup.</li> <li>• Taking part in whole school harvest celebrations and visiting the church.</li> <li>• Counting objects and actions that cannot be moved and selecting numerals.</li> </ul>	<p><b>Week Beginning:</b> 15<sup>th</sup> October 2018 <b>Theme:</b> Fairy Tale Characters</p> <p>The children will be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Learning a selection of rhymes including Humpty Dumpty and the Grand Old Duke of York.</li> <li>• Creating their own version of the Humpty Dumpty character and creating a safe place for him to stay.</li> <li>• Building using a variety of materials including bricks and construction kits.</li> <li>• Looking at different types of transport and talking about their own experiences.</li> <li>• Identifying a selection of 2d shapes; naming and describing them.</li> </ul>
