

<p>Week Beginning: 11th September 2017 Theme: Twinkle, Twinkle Little Star</p> <p>The children will be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Meeting and interacting with the adults in the Reception base and becoming familiar with the routines and expectations. • Exploring the learning environment and talking about their likes and interests. • Managing their own toileting and selecting food for lunch from the available choices. • Learning the rhyme 'twinkle, twinkle little star' and variations of the words. • Creating their own stars using a selection of collage and creative materials. • Making star biscuits; following a recipe and talking about home experiences. 	<p>Week Beginning: 18th September 2017 Theme: In the Garden</p> <p>The children will be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Meeting and interacting with the adults in the Reception base and becoming familiar with the routines and expectations. • Exploring the learning environment and talking about their likes and interests. • Managing their own toileting and selecting food for lunch from the available choices. • Learning a selection of rhymes including Incy Wincy Spider and Mary, Mary Quite Contrary. • Creating observational drawings of flowers and natural objects. • Creating spider and flower models. 	<p>Week Beginning: 25th September 2017 Theme: On the Farm</p> <p>The children will be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Learning a selection of rhymes based on the farm and the animals that live there, including 'Old MacDonald had a farm'. • Identifying different animals and talking about their features. • Looking at different types of sheep and talking about their differences. • Making sheep biscuits; following a recipe and talking about their home experiences. • Using a variety of painting techniques including printing and rolling. • Taking part in phase one phonic activities including listening to and identifying sounds.
<p>Week Beginning: 2nd October 2017 Theme: Frogs</p> <p>The children will be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Learning a selection of songs and rhymes about frogs including 5 speckled frogs. • Making their own frogs from paper plates and card. • Finding out about different types of frogs and where they live. • Talking about the lifecycle of a frog and identifying the stages of growth. • Visiting a pond and finding out about the life that lives there. • Recognise numbers 1 to 5 and count groups of objects. 	<p>Week Beginning: 9th October 2017 Theme: Harvest</p> <p>The children will be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Reading the story of little red hen and learning about where bread comes from. • Making our own bread and tasting bread from around the world. • Finding out about how vegetables are grown and planting our own vegetables. • Tasting different vegetables and making vegetable soup. • Taking part in whole school harvest celebrations and visiting the church. • Counting objects and actions that cannot be moved and selecting numerals. 	<p>Week Beginning: 16th October 2017 Theme: Fairy Tale Characters</p> <p>The children will be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Learning a selection of rhymes including Humpty Dumpty and the Grand Old Duke of York. • Creating their own version of the Humpty Dumpty character and creating a safe place for him to stay. • Building using a variety of materials including bricks and construction kits. • Looking at different types of transport and talking about their own experiences. • Identifying a selection of 2d shapes; naming and describing them.
