Next term we have a new lunch menu. I have attached the full menu to this round us. The menu for the first week back is below:



Local Authority Wraparound Care Survey

The Government intends to make available 'wraparound care' outside of normal school hours, so that parents of primary school-aged children can access childcare in their local area from 8am-6pm. This will include term time breakfast clubs and after-school clubs. It is intended that by September 2026, most primary schools or their partner organisations will be able to provide before and after school care. The wraparound care will be fee paying, but some parents will be able to get help with costs through tax free childcare or universal credit.

We therefore ask if you could please complete the short survey which should only take 5 minutes of your time. The deadline for completion is 4 November 2023.
