Dear Parents and Children,

Welcome back to a very busy half term.

## Reading

Reading books will continue to be changed on a Monday for Class 2K and a Tuesday for Class 2B. Please ensure that your child has their book bag in school on this day, a compact timetable means that we do not have the opportunity to change books at any other time during the week.

## Homework

Children will be given a Maths book and an English sheet (either a grammar sheet or a picture to write about).

Homework will be handed out on a Friday and will collect back in on a Monday. This will be the same for both classes.

## PE

P.E will be on a Monday and Thursday for Class 2B and on a Tuesday and Thursday for Class 2K. Children need to be dressed appropriately in a white T-shirt, black shorts and black plimsolls (No trainers please). On these days, please ensure that children with long hair have it tied back, and that earrings are removed as we are unable to do this in school.

Our school policy states that we are unable to allow children wearing earrings to participate in PE lessons for safety reasons.

It is really helpful if all of your child's PE kit is named, they have a tendency to throw their clothes around the room so it makes it easier to reunite the clothes with their owners.
