Dear Parents and Children,

Welcome back! We hope that you had a relaxing and cheerful Easter break with your friends and family.

## Reading

Reading books will continue to be changed on a **Wednesday for 2V and a Thursday for 2B.**

Please ensure that your child has their book bag (with their books and their reading log inside it) in school **every day**, as we complete a lot of reading activities with the children throughout the week.

Please continue to comment in your child's Reading Log once they have read their books. This helps us to know that your child is reading and we can then change their books. If your child is a Free Reader, it is not expected that they sit and read the whole book to you, but it is useful if you listen to them read a couple of chapters and then discuss what happened with them.

- What happened in the story?
- What was their favourite part? Why?
- Who was their favourite character? Why?
- Would they change any of the story? Why?

If you need some more help, then please remember to look at the bookmarks that we handed out during parents' evening earlier this year.

The library book is a book that your child will have chosen. This is something for you to read together. Of course, once your child becomes more confident they might read the entire book to you!

## Homework

English and Maths homework books will continue to be handed out on a Friday and will be collected back in on a Monday. This will be the same for both classes.

We will continue to send spellings home this term. These will be sent home on a Friday with their Maths and English books. Please continue to work on these words with the children as it really strengthens their writing.

## Charanga Yumu

Earlier this year, your child was sent home with their Charanga Yumu log in. Charanga Music World is a great way to practise music online. There are lots of activities, games and quizzes for your child to enjoy and they are regularly updated.

## Water bottles

Please remember that your child needs a named water bottle every day.

## Sun Cream

As it starts to get warmer, children are encouraged to apply sun cream in the morning before school and to bring in sun hats for playtimes.

## PE

PE will be on continue to be on **Thursdays and Fridays for 2V and Tuesdays and Wednesdays for 2B. This could be subject to change.** Children still need to have black shorts, a white t-shirt, plimsolls as well as a track suit (preferably a neutral coloured one) in their PE kits. Children are allowed to wear trainers when we have our PE lessons outside. The children should have their P.E kits in every day.

Our school policy states that we are unable to allow children wearing earrings to participate in PE lessons for safety reasons.

It is really helpful if all of your child's PE kit is named so that misplaced clothes can be reunited with their owners quickly.
